Level 3 is in Maths, Science & Cyber only.

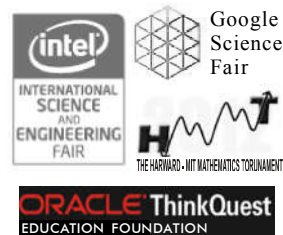
