**Level - 1** : All Level-1 successful\* participants will get certificate, aptitude report and online subscription, and school toppers will be eligible for school hero medals.

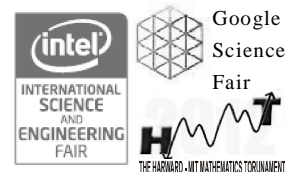

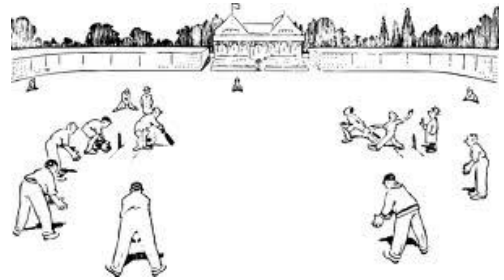
