Level 3 is in Maths, Science & Cyber only.

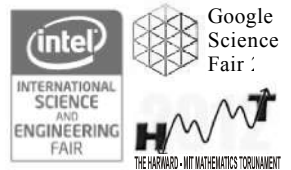
- You are allowed additional 10 minutes to fill the required details in the **RESPONSE SHEET**.

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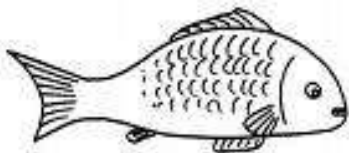
